**CITIZENS XELERATOR**

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## Description

Developed within the framework of the [Citizens Xelerator project](#), this model and kit provide a structured approach to enable adults with unmet literacy needs to enhance their literacy, and promote democratic and civic engagement in their local communities. The model focuses on promoting personal, social, and learning competences while encouraging active participation in community initiatives.

The Citizens Xelerator model and kit provide the resources and materials that will be used in Citizens Xelerator Action Labs during the project's pilot phase, which will be implemented at national level in the eight countries of the partnership. The Citizens Xelerator Action Labs will offer spaces where adults can access resources and guidance to develop and launch locally based solutions to social and sustainability challenges.

The main objectives of the Citizens Xelerator Action Labs are to:

1. **Address Challenges:** Tackle social, human, and sustainable challenges in local communities.
2. **Develop Competences:** Enhance adults' personal, social, and learning competences.
3. **Promote Civic Engagement:** Increase opportunities for democratic and civic engagement among adults with unmet literacy needs.
4. **Strengthen Partnerships:** Expand strategic partnerships to improve adults' literacy, competences, and empowerment.

## Citizens Xelerator project

The Citizens Xelerator project is a two-year European project which has as its main objectives:

- To strengthen the democratic and civic literacy and social empathy of low-skilled adults;
- To contribute to a systemic change in regional/national/European approaches and strategies to foster adult participation in democratic life, embracing common values and civic engagement.

Citizens Xelerator is coordinated by Mentortec (Portugal) with the participation of eight partner organisations from eight countries: AAH (Greece), ACEFIR (Spain), AEAE (Romania), AONTAS (Ireland), APCEP (Portugal), CESIE (Italy), DANTE (Croatia), and VHS (Germany).

The main target groups of the Citizens Xelerator project are:

- Adult education professionals
- Adult education providers
- Adults with unmet literacy needs
- Civil society organizations

# Implementing the Citizens Xelerator Action Lab activities/initiatives

### Posters

### Social Media Posts

### Press Releases

Your ability to customise the survey means that you can capture relevant and meaningful feedback from your participants, regardless of the diverse settings in which the activities take place.

By analysing this feedback, you can make informed decisions, fostering continuous improvement and ensuring the initiatives align closely with their intended goals.
